**SUMMARY OF BENEFIT** Members of IHEA participate in organized meetings that offer interaction with key executives in the industry. IHEA offers its members the opportunity to serve on committees, meet with related industry associations, business leaders, government officials, participate in seminars, and other affiliate organizations.

#### **DETAILS OF BENEFIT**

**Annual Meeting** - Members of the Industrial Heating Equipment Association meet each spring at a location in the United States. The annual meeting is designed to provide a forum for members to discuss timely topics and listen to current reports on issues and matters affecting the industry. In addition to the daily meetings, social events are planned that offer unique opportunities to be with members and guest speakers.

**Fall Business Conference** - This annual conference, held in October, brings together IHEA officers, directors, and representatives of member companies who serve on committees. This single day event includes committee meetings, reports by government and industry leaders, and an evening event.

**IHEA Committees** - IHEA currently has seven active Committees. Committee participation offers an opportunity to work with other members on issues important to the association and the industry.

**Access to Related Trade Associations** - Develop and maintain relationships with related trade associations, domestic and foreign, in order to assimilate global information about the industry

**Government Relations** - IHEA has relationships with U.S. government agencies including the Department of Commerce, Department of Energy, Environmental Protection Agency, Bureau of Census, Small Business Administration and others. The Association provides assistance to members in making contact with the agencies or seeking information on matters of interest.

**Seminar Participation** - Representatives from member companies serve as the faculty members of the seminars sponsored by IHEA. This involvement creates a bond between the suppliers and users providing a better understanding of the concerns, needs and technology interests.

**Affiliations** - IHEA maintains memberships and is active in the following organizations: U.S. Chamber of Commerce, National Association of Manufacturers and the National Fire Protection Agency.
